Subject: Kulite Semiconductor Products, Inc. AD-DSL Compliance Declaration

The International Aerospace Environmental Group (IAEG) has adopted the IPC-1754 standard for materials and substances declaration for aerospace and defense (AD) and other industries to volunteer declarations in the AD industry and its global supply chain. To comply with this standard, the IAEG has developed the Aerospace and Defense Declarable Substance List (AD-DSL) to help companies identify and manage their use of approximately 1,200 listed chemical substances that are commonly used in the manufacture, repair, and ongoing maintenance of aerospace and defense products. Compliance to the AD-DSL is voluntary, but helps to facilitate compliance across a variety of regulations that may apply to the substances commonly used in the AD industry.

There are 4 different regulatory criteria that apply to each AD-DSL entry. They give users an indication of why a substance is included on the list, but the presence or absence of any IAEG criterion is not an indication of whether a substance may or may not be used in AD products or processes. The criterion is as follows:

- **Restricted in articles (R1):** At least one regulation, in one or more regions, restricts (totally or partially) the presence of the substance in AD articles and/or requires an authorization/permit in order to continue to use the substance in articles.
- **Restricted in Substances and Mixtures (R2):** At least one regulation, in one or more regions, restricts (totally or partially) the use of the substance (either alone or in mixtures) and/or requires an authorization/permit in order to continue to use the substance.
- **Declarable in articles (D1):** At least one regulation, in one or more regions, requires the disclosure of the substance when present in AD articles.
- **Of Interest (I):** The substance is not currently identified as meeting any criteria for R1, R2 or D1; however, it may be otherwise regulated in one or more regions. The substance is of interest due to uses in AD applications and may have been identified as a candidate for future regulatory activity in at least one region.

Kulite has scaled the AD-DSL and identified the listed substances in our final products, which is available upon customer request. Listed substances used in Kulite processes are not included in our declaration. Our compliance to the AD-DSL is imperative to our commitment towards environmental stewardship and continuous improvement.
